**City of Newton Operational Plan for LCID Landfill**

- Owner/Operator: City of Newton
  
- Location: 1171 Boston Road  
Newton, NC 28658

- Daily Operations: The city will be using the facility to dispose of concrete and asphalt debris extracted during repair operations. The city will also allow contractors working on the cities behalf to be allowed to dump in the facility. There is a police firing range on-site that is adjacent to the LCID area.
  
- Hours of operation: The hours of operation for the LCID property are from 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM. During operational hours the gate remains unlocked. After the normal hours and on weekends, the gate going into the property will be locked under city issued lock and key.
  
- Estimated tonnage: Tonnages are based on the past couple of years. The closest estimate available would be around 300 – 350 tons annually.
  
- Emergency plan: The cities fire department will respond to all calls at Boston Rd. Facility.

- Daily Operations: Small Type 1 Unit Composting plan: The city will compost the brush, leaves and chipping material collected daily from within the city limits as required by North Carolina Administrative Code 15A NCAC.
1. The city will form wind rows and aerate then monthly.
  2. The city will annually turn leaves.
  3. The compost process will be maintained at or above 131 degrees Fahrenheit (55 Celsius) for three days and compost aerated as needed to maintain those temperatures.
  4. Temperatures will be taken daily or weekly to monitor the wind rows temperatures.
  5. As necessary the city will have a tub grinder brought in to grind the composted material and haul it away.
  6. Staff will maintain a log book to document incoming loads of materials by volume, composting dates and temperatures, grinding operations, and outgoing loads of compost.
- Hours of operation: The hours of operation for the LCID property are from 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM. During operational hours the gate remains unlocked. After the normal hours and on weekends, the gate going into the property will be locked under city issued lock and key.
- Estimated tonnage: The composting unit will process or store less than 6,000 cubic yards of material per quarter.
- Emergency plan: The cities fire department will respond to all calls at Boston Rd. Facility.
