Hello Larry,

Per our phone conversation we would like to request to make a few changes to our operating procedures at our transfer station.

1. We would like to install a picking station to better sort our recyclables.
2. We are requesting to stockpile concrete and yard debris for purposes of grinding and crushing. We feel that rain will not cause any leach aid for these two products.
3. We would like to be able to leave enough C&D on the pad each afternoon so we can start production each morning. As of now, we are having to wait each day for the trucks to bring the first load in and we are losing valuable hours each day. If permitted to do so, we will cover the pad each night with a tarp to keep any rain and wind from blowing the debris.
4. We would like to remove the leachaid tank from the site. We will fill the drain with concrete to cap it off since we cannot operate in the rain. We will use a speedy dry material if any wet loads are dumped to absorb any liquids. The ground around the tank keeps collapsing the tank. To Date we have not used it and really do not see the need for it.

These are a few of the growing pains in which we are experiencing and we are sure that there will be many more as the company continues to grow. I do appreciate your help in these matters and look forward to hearing from you. I need to know where we need to send a check for the changes to the permit and is there a formal form that needs to be filled out. I will be out of town the week of the 20th to the 24th. and unable to talk via phone so please respond via e-mail
