Re: Approval to Operate: Soundside C&D Waste Transfer & Recycling Center, Currituck County, North Carolina, Permit No. 27-05T-Tranfer-2011, Doc ID No. 16316

Dear Mr. Newbern, and Mr. and Mrs. Newbern:

Soundside C&D Waste Transfer & Recycling Center, permit 2705T, Pasquotank County, has constructed the new C&D waste transfer facility at the new area on the property, on the east side of the power easement, reference permit issued February 18, 2011, Doc ID 12932. The facility construction was not in accordance with the approved plan in that the new facility is smaller than proposed, and not all components and areas are constructed (for example, the conveyor sorting line, the gypsum storage area, the LCID staging area and associated sedimentation basin #2, and the Recycling and Processing area are not constructed). The Solid Waste Section has agreed to allow the operation to begin on a smaller scale.

The pre-operative conditions of Soundside C&D Waste Transfer & Recycling Center, permit 2705 issued February 18, 2011, have been met for a smaller scale operation, and the waste transfer and recycling facility may begin operation in the new area, on the east side of the power easement, in accordance with the certification letter, Doc ID 16165 and with the following requirements:

1. Within 45 days, the facility operation must be moved to the approved new area on the east side of the power easement, and the area of the existing operation must be cleared or converted to the Product Sales Area, as described in the approved plan, Doc ID 12931. The debris, gypsum, and contaminated mulch at the existing operation area must be removed from the site or moved to the new operations area if appropriate.
2. The plywood boards adjacent to the concrete tipping floor area must not be used as a tipping floor/sorting/storage area for wastes or recyclables.

3. Site components or areas that are not constructed and included in the February 17, 2012 certification (Doc ID 16165), but that are constructed in the future, must be certified by the Project Engineer and approved by the Solid Waste Section before operation of the added component or area.
