Mr. Barnett:

The Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (Section) has completed the review of the *Operations Plan* (DIN 16174) submitted in request of a five-year renewal of the Permit to Operate. The document was received in the Asheville Regional Office on February 27, 2012.

The submittal has been reviewed for completeness in accordance with General Statute 130A-295.8(e). A determination of completeness means that the application includes all required components but does not mean the required components provide all of the information that is required for the Section to make a decision on the application. The permitting activity fee, in addition to the components required by 15A NCAC 13B.0401, has been submitted so the application is deemed complete.

Based on this review, it has been determined the Section requires clarification or revisions in order to approve the Operations Plan. Please provide a response for each of the followings items and revise the Operation Plan as necessary:

1. The Section IV. Facility Descriptions and Section VI. Operation Plan part E. Wastewater Management use the word "wastewater" in describing liquids emanating from waste or generated as a result of water coming in contact with waste or the tipping floor. We request each of these references be changed to "leachate" in order to match the more specific definition of liquids coming from or percolating through waste as found in 15A NCAC 13B .0101(24). The reference to Shamrock Environmental Corporation's facility does not need to be changed.
2. Section VI. Operation Plan part F. Hazard and Nuisance Control, Litter states: *Windblown material, if any, will be picked up and discarded as needed.* 15A NCAC 13B.0402(7) requires that all windblown material resulting from the operation shall be collected at the conclusion of each day of operation. The language in the Plan must be revised in order to agree with the Rule requirements.
