Please find the enclosed Permit to Construct and Permit to Operate for the Fogleman and Fogleman Landfill & Recycling Facility. This permit approves the continued operation of the land clearing and inert debris (LCID) landfill and the establishment and operation of an LCID processing area. Richardson Smith Gardner & Associates will provide you a copy of the approved operation plan.

In general, the facility permit does not reiterate permit conditions which are included in the Solid Waste Management Rules, 15A NCAC 13B, nor does it restate specific conditions which are included within the approved plans. Please review the conditions of the permit thoroughly.

A certified copy of the permit is also included. This must be filed in the Durham County Register of Deeds office and the recorded copy returned to the Permitting Branch Supervisor within 30 days as stated in Attachment 1, Part IV, Condition 3.
