Dear Mr. Boone:

The Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section has received the application for five year permit amendment for Rocky Mount LCID Landfill Permit number 33G-LCID. After a thorough review of the permit file, the amendment application is not due until December 2009. The following are few items in the application submittal that require clarification and/or revision when you are resubmitting the application.

Operations Plan

1. Please include a description of signs to be posted at the entrance and within the site to direct traffic. Signs must provide a description of the type of waste received, the types of waste prohibited, operating hours, permit number, and emergency contact phone numbers.
2. Include a description of site security and access control.
3. Include recordkeeping and contingency plans in the operation plan.
4. Personnel requirements, qualification and responsibilities. The plan must indicate that a trained employee must be onsite at all times the site is open.

Seasonal High Water Table

According to the rule 15A NCAC 13B. 0564 “Siting Criteria for Land Clearing and Inert Debris (LCID) Landfills”, information showing that the bottom elevation of the waste shall be four feet above the seasonal high water table is required. Please modify the design plan to depict this information.

Map

Provide a map or aerial photograph with a scale of at least one inch equals four hundred feet showing the area within one-fourth mile of the site. The map must include but not limited to all homes, buildings, public or private utilities, roads, wells, water ways, and any other applicable features.

Electronic Copy

Submit a cover letter and an electronic copy of all the required documents on a CD or by email, whichever works best for you.
