
On Tuesday, July 13, 2010, you and I discussed, by phone, the proper permitting of a new waste stream at the BMWNC, Inc. Medical Waste Treatment Facility located in Gaston County, Permit No. 36-11. The waste you described was United States Department of Agriculture, Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service, Plant Protection and Quarantine (USDA/APHIS/PPQ) or APHIS – Regulated Garbage. The purpose of this letter is to provide you with the information that the permit owner/operator, BMWNC, will be required to submit, to the Section, in order to modify the facility's permit to operate. A complete application should include;

1. A signed written request for modification of the permit to operate. The request must include the facility's permit number and should clearly state the permit owner/operator's desire to treat APHIS – Regulated Garbage at the facility; this is typically in the form of a cover letter.
2. A properly executed Compliance Agreement between APHIS and the permit owner/operator; this typically on a form provided by APHIS.
3. Any other information that may be pertinent to the request for permit modification.

Upon receipt, the Section will process the application in accordance with North Carolina General Statutes and Administrative Code, including the invoicing of the applicant for the appropriate permit fee.
