

Subject: Permit Fee City of Greensboro White Street Landfill

I am returning the check for permit fee in the amount of \$1500.00 because the amount is in error. The application which is in house is for a five-year renewal of a permit which by statute 130A-295.8(b)(2) is a permit amendment. The landfill according to the application received June 2008 and past history, would take in excess of 100,000 tons per year of waste. The invoice (SWCDT08-00010) sent by the Solid Waste Section on November 5, 2008 is for \$18,500.00 as is specified by statute.

Based on a cursory review at the application we will not be issuing another invoice for a lesser amount. It is not specified in the local government approval letter, which was included in the application, how much waste is allowed to go into this facility annually. It is stated on the first page of text of the application titled Construction and Demolition Application Overview that “based on an estimated waste density and projected waste receipt, Phase II final contours should be reached in approximately 5 years” and “The permit modification fee for a C&D facility greater than 100,000 tons per year is \$2500.” The Public Meeting minutes also reflect that the landfill will close in 5 years. The public notice text states that “the remaining capacity of the landfill is approximately 750,000 tons.” or 150,000 tons per year. All indications within the application are that the annual waste receipt is expected to be greater than 100,000 tons.

The permitting engineer within the Solid Waste Section should be contacted if the application needs to be changed.
