Dear Ms. Covington:

The Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (Section) received and reviewed the *City of Greensboro – White Street Landfill, C&D Landfill Permit Application (DIN 10204)* for the continued operation of the landfill in accordance with 15A NCAC 13B .0547. The appropriate permit fee was recently received.

Your application can now be considered complete within the context of General Statute §130A-295.8(e). A determination of completeness means that that application includes all required components but does not mean that the required components provide all of the information that is required for the Section to make a decision on the application. The technical review letter issued October 29, 2010 (DIN 11973) addressed information needed in order to proceed with the permitting process.

Under General Statute §150B-3, when an applicant makes a timely and sufficient application for issuance of a permit, the existing permit does not expire until a final decision on the application is made by the Section. Therefore, until the final decision is made, the City of Greensboro is authorized to continue operation of the City of Greensboro, White Street C&DLF in accordance with your most recent Solid Waste Permit and the Solid Waste Management Rules (15A NCAC 13B).
