The Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (Section) received and reviewed the permit application submitted for the continued operation of the City of Greensboro – White Street Compost Facility. The Section also received the appropriate permit fee.

Your application can now be considered complete within the context of General Statute §130A-295.8(e). A determination of completeness means that that application includes all required components but does not mean that the required components provide all of the information that is required for the Section to make a decision on the application. A technical review of the application will be conducted and you will be notified of any concerns or the need for additional information.

Under General Statute §150B-3, when an applicant makes a timely and sufficient application for issuance of a permit, the existing permit does not expire until a final decision on the application is made by the Section. Therefore, until the final decision is made, the City of Greensboro is authorized to continue operation of the City of Greensboro, White Street Compost Facility in accordance with your most recent Solid Waste Permit and the Solid Waste Management Rules (15A NCAC 13B).
