Dear Mr. Wyrick:

Please find the enclosed Permit to Operate for the City of Greensboro, White Street Landfill – Phase III Municipal Solid Waste Landfill (MSWLF), Permit No. 41-12, which approves the continued operation of the facility, and the approved copy of the application with operation plan. This permit contains only one part: a Permit to Operate. It does not include a Permit to Construct because all cells have been constructed in accordance with the site study approved by the City of Greensboro (City) government in 1995.

The permit amendment application was received in the Winston-Salem Regional office on January 14, 2010. This was in accordance with condition 1 of the General Facility Conditions in the Permit to Operate issued April 14, 2005, and pursuant to 15A NCAC 13B .0201(g) for a five year permit review. The approved application contains all the elements required under 15A NCAC 13B .1617 for a permit amendment application including an updated operation plan. The updated operation plan calls for continuing to fill the landfill to build out conditions that were previously approved by the City and permitted by the Department of Environment and Natural Resources.

Prior to issuance, a compliance history was conducted and indicated no compliance issues to prevent issuance of this permit amendment. In addition, the City of Greensboro paid permitting fees and updated the facility financial assurance as required by statute.

If the landfill reaches the permitted capacity during the next five years, the City must commence closure in accordance with the approved closure plan. If permitted capacity remains at the end of five years, another permit amendment application must be submitted.

In general, the facility permit does not reiterate permit conditions which are included in the Solid Waste Management Rules, 15A NCAC 13B, nor does it restate specific conditions which are included within the approved plans.

A certified copy of this permit showing current ownership and property used for the solid waste management facility is also enclosed. Please file this copy with the Guilford County Register of Deeds indexed under the name of the owner. The certified copy of the permit affixed with the Register's seal and the date, book, and page number of the recording must be returned to the Section within 30 calendar days of issuance of this permit.
