Notice of public comment period on draft Permit Number 41-16, allowing the expansion of the service area of the WCA of High Point Construction and Demolition Debris (C&D) Landfill, pursuant to 15A NCAC 13B .0531, et seq. is hereby given. This draft permit will also allow the acceptance of cardboard and wood waste from non-C&D sources for reclamation.

WCA of High Point, LLC (WCA), a wholly-owned subsidiary of WCA Waste Corporation, owns and operates a C&D landfill and reclamation pad at 5830 Riverdale Drive in the City of High Point. WCA requested a change in their franchise agreement with the City of High Point to expand the franchise area. The franchise was amended to add Rockingham, Caswell, Alamance, Orange, Cabarrus, Rowan, Davie, Yadkin, Surry, and Stokes counties to the previously approved Randolph, Davidson, Forsyth, and Guilford counties. The draft permit reflects this change in service area. The draft permit also allows the acceptance cardboard and wood waste from non-C&D sources for processing in the reclamation area of the facility. The daily intake for the facility will not change from the last permit issued on July 21, 2010.

North Carolina Solid Waste Management Rules require that the public be given a 45-day period to comment on this draft permit. The comment period will begin March 1, 2011, and end at 5:00 p.m. on April 15, 2011. 
