





RE: A-1 Sandrock, Inc.
Treatment and Processing Facility Application

Dear Mr. Mussler,

Guilford County Planning and Development has reviewed the plans for the proposed Treatment and Processing (T&P) facility at the A-1 Sandrock, Inc. site, located at 2091 Bishop Road, Greensboro, NC, and determined that the proposed T&P facility is allowable under the current zoning and/or provisions of the Special Use Permits for the site. The County understands that the T&P facility will be located at a permitted and partially constructed (but not yet operational) Construction and Demolition (C&D) debris landfill, which is also allowed under the State's Solid Waste rules to accept Land Clearing Inert Debris (LCID) materials. The County further understands that the T&P facility will receive, process (grind and stockpile) and distribute inert materials (mostly woody debris and recycled aggregates) derived from its permitted waste stream.

By this letter Guilford County has no objection to the granting of a T&P permit to A-1 Sandrock, Inc. by NCDENR Division of Waste Management, with the understanding that the facility will only accept and process LCID materials until a Permit to Operate is issued by the Division for the C&D landfill. A-1 Sandrock, Inc. has agreed to abide by this T&P material limitation until such time that further approvals are granted by the Division and Guilford County.
