Dear Mr. Chao:

Pursuant to our telephone conversation of November 16, 2011, I have reviewed the drawings of Phases 1A and 1B and verified that the acreage is indeed 7.26 acres. I have also reviewed the Permit to Operate issued on February 28, 2011 and verified that the document authorized operation of all of Phase 1B. As such, I am of the opinion that no action is required by the Solid Waste Section. The recently submitted documents from me, pertaining to the remainder of Phase 1B, should be considered by the Section as "For Information Only."

A-1 Sandrock acknowledges that the authorized Permit to Construct for Phase 1 (including 1A, 1B, and 1C) involves 8.18 acres, which is the amount determined for the Financial Assurance now in force. The facility management understands that further authorization will be required for Phase 2 and beyond, i.e., any disposal area exceeding 8.18 acres. The figures and photos enclosed with the earlier submittal should stand sufficient.
