The draft permit also includes conditions for operating miscellaneous waste management units at the facility. Impact to groundwater from the closed unlined MSWLF (Area 1) requires the implementation of a corrective action plan. An assessment of corrective measures for groundwater treatment was presented at a public meeting

held **March 11, 2008**. The selected remedies include monitored natural attenuation paired with a landfill gas recovery system to control decomposition gases. The draft permit contains conditions for implementing, operating, and assessing the corrective action plan.

Rules require that the general public be given a 45-day period to comment on this draft permit. The comment period will begin on **January 30, 2011**, and end at 5:00 PM on **March 15, 2011**. Comments should be submitted in writing to Ming-Tai Chao, (Ming.Chao@ncdenr.gov or 919-508-8507) division contact, at the address listed above.
