Further, the facility and/or all responsible parties may be subject to enforcement actions including penalties, injunction from operation of a solid waste management facility or a solid waste collection service and any such further relief as may be necessary to achieve compliance with the North Carolina Solid Waste Management Act and Rules.

**ADDITIONAL COMMENTS:**

1. Visited facility and met briefly with Ms. Bullard at office. Tire processing was not underway on the day of inspection due to maintenance operations. This facility processes scrap tires by grinding, and the tire-derived product is marketed as feedstock for commercial applications; the product is also permitted to be disposed at the adjacent Central Carolina Tire Disposal monofill, Solid Waste Permit No. 43-04.
2. Observed that the facility was generally in good order. Observed several tires outside designated storage areas; take actions to return and maintain scrap tires in storage areas in accordance with the approved facility site and operations plans. Processed-tire product should be removed regularly from the ground in the Treatment & Processing area and managed properly in accordance with the approved Operations Plan.
3. Observed that vectors were not a problem at the time of inspection.
4. Observed that wind-blown waste was not a problem at the time of inspection.
