Mr. Giauque:

The Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (Section) has completed the review of the document titled *Landfill No. 6, One-time waste biosolids disposal, Permit Number 44-06 (DIN 16799)*. The document was received in the Asheville Regional Office on June 22, 2012.

The analytical results provided with the request indicate the biosolids, or “soap” solids, are non-hazardous and non-liquid. Based on this information, this letter serves as an authorization for the one-time disposal, in the Area-D, South disposal unit, of the biosolids from one process tank. Disposal of the biosolids must be managed in accordance with the currently approved Operations Plan. There are no permit conditions associated with this activity so no permit modification will be required and no permit fee assessed.

Additionally, I would recommend modifying your Operations Plan to allow for this waste material if the disposal of biosolids may be required again in the future. This would require a modification to the Permit, but could be done in conjunction with any other required permitting activity.
