Items for our discussion.

1. Discuss a Permit Modification to our Operational Plan to include Santek. I would also like to discuss a Substantial Amendment to the permit to change our service area.
2. Could we get you or someone else at DENR to put in writing their opinion that the County is not required to have a public hearing under the guidelines of GS 130A-294(b). I agree that what we are proposing is not a franchise. If it was a franchise, we would have to also comply with GS 153A-46 which requires that it be passed at two regular meetings and that an ordinance be adopted. Santek didn't propose a franchise. However, our Request for Proposals in Section 2 does state that the proposal was contingent on approval of permit requirements of the State and performance of all services in accordance with State rules and regulations, including but not limited to the State's requirements for solid waste management franchises set forth in NC GS 130A-294. So, even though this may not be a franchise, we did make this as a requirement in our RFP.
