Dear Mr. Russell:

The Solid Waste Section (SWS) has not received information it requested for the continued operation of the LCID landfill listed above. The SWS stated in its telephone conversation on June 8, 2010 that in order to issue a permit for continued operation, the area in which operations are to occur for the next five years, Cell 2, should be delineated. The SWS followed up this request with a letter dated June 15, 2010 (Doc ID 10742). The proposed addition of grinding and stockpile areas also required more information, and the SWS communicated that requirement in the aforementioned letter. In an email communication dated June 17, 2010, the SWS requested information regarding disposal of dead animals at the site (Doc ID 10886). To date no information is received for any of the SWS requests.

Continued operation with an expired permit may result in enforcement action. Repeated below are the requests the SWS specified.

1. Submit a revised Plansheet 4 of 7 depicting boundaries of the area of disposal for the next five years.
2. Specify the volume, acreage, tonnage, and side slopes of the proposed stockpile area and specify how long material will be stockpiled.
3. Submit a revised Operations Plan that includes operation for disposal of dead animals.

Under the North Carolina Solid Waste Management Act, 15A NCAC 13B .0563(4), Permits to Operate LCID landfills are issued for not more than five (5) years. SWS records indicate that the Permit to Operate for the above referenced facility expired. An application to renew the permit has been received (Doc ID 10366); however, the information listed above is required before the permit can be renewed.

To obtain a 5-year permit amendment for the LCID landfill referenced above and avoid enforcement action, the specified information must be submitted to the SWS. Please be aware



that you must respond to this letter by Friday, July 30, 2010 to maintain compliance with the NC Solid Waste Management Rules.

Should you choose to not submit the above listed information by the requested date, then closure of the facility must be initiated within 120 days of receipt of this letter. If you fail to initiate closure or not respond by the specified date, you will be subject to enforcement action, which may include injunctive action and/or the assessment of administrative penalties of up to \$15,000 per day for each day of continued violation of any requirement of the Act, the rule, or any condition of your permit, including failure to properly apply for renewal of the facility's permit.
