Mr. Lambert:

The Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (Section) has completed the review of the letter seeking clarification on receipt of de-watered septage and grease trap waste (DIN 12368). The document was received in the Asheville Regional Office on December 6, 2010.

Based on this review, there is no reason for the Section to deny the acceptance of de-watered septage and grease trap waste at the Iredell County MSW Landfill Facility. There are no prohibitions regarding the activity in the General Statutes, Administrative Code or the Operation Plan. As a result, you may proceed with the proposed activity in accordance with the submittal referenced above and the facility Operation Plan. However, I would like to remind you that liquid wastes, per 15A NCAC 13B.1626(1)(b)(iii), are prohibited from disposal in MSW landfill facilities. Therefore, it is critical to ensure all loads of the de-watered septage and grease trap waste have passed the Paint Filter Liquids Test prior to disposal.
