Dear Mr. Lambert:

The Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (Section) has completed the technical review of the submittal (DIN 10167) for the Operation and Site Plans that were received on February 25, 2010 for the Iredell County Transfer Station-Mooresville.

The submittals have also been reviewed for completeness in accordance with General Statute 130A-295.8(e). A determination of completeness means that the application includes all required components but does not mean that the required components provide all of the information that is required for the Section to make a decision on the application. The permitting activity fee in addition to the components required by 15ANCAC 13B.0401 have been submitted so the application is deemed complete

It has been determined the Section requires clarification or additional information in order to approve the Operation and Site Plans. Please provide a response for each of the followings items and revise the Plans as necessary.

1. Section V, Operation Plan-E. Wastewater Management

Please provide a detailed plan of all wastewater inlets (floor drains), piping, etc. Some liquids are being tracked from the tipping floor across the concrete area and draining around the curb on the north side of the building. An oil/water separator or some other treatment structure may be needed. Water that comes into contact with solid waste must be contained on-site or properly treated prior to discharge from the site. An NPDES permit may be required prior to discharge to surface waters;

2. V. Operation Plan-F. Hazard and Nuisance Control

Include the following language, as per 15A NCAC 13B.0402 (7) into your Operation Plan, “At the conclusion of each day of operation, all windblown material resulting from the operation will be collected and returned to the area by the owner or operator.”

In addition to the Plan revisions the facility must complete an Environmental Compliance Review according to NCGS 130A-295.3. Mr. Donald Herndon, Compliance Officer, will be contacting you, under separate cover, regarding any further information that may be needed to satisfy this requirement.
