The Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (Section) has completed the review of the drawing titled *White Goods Facility Grease Interceptor* (DIN 12771). The document was submitted on your behalf by Municipal Engineering Services and was received in the Asheville Regional Office on January 19, 2011.
