Mr. Parker:

The Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (Section) has completed review of the document titled *Operations Plan Scott Creek Transfer Station* (DIN 9799).

It has been determined the Operations Plan requires several revisions:

1. The date on the title page, and throughout the document, is November 12, 2008. Please use the current date or add a revision date.
2. Section I. Introduction, Part A. states *all personnel involved with the management or supervision on the facility will be required to review the Operations Plan and maintain the facility in conformance with the applicable requirements.* Please revise this statement to include all personnel involved in the operation of the facility.
3. Section II. Operation, Parts A., G., and E. discuss operations specific to the old facility. The discussion of all operations needs to be updated to include the facilities and services. An example is the description of leachate management in Part E. Housekeeping and Litter Control.
4. Section II. Operation, Part C. Inspection and Acceptance of Wastes states *personnel will...contact DENR and the local Hazardous Materials Emergency Response Team.* Please include contact information for both parties.
