Mr. Miller:

The Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (Section) has completed the technical review of the Operation Plan (DIN10540) submitted in support of the five-year renewal of the Permit to Operate.

In addition, the submittal has been reviewed for completeness in accordance with General Statute 130A-295.8(e). A determination of completeness means that the application includes all required components but does not mean that the required components provide all of the information that is required for the Section to make a decision on the application. The permitting activity fee, in addition to the components required by 15A NCAC 13B.0401, has been submitted so the application is deemed complete.

Based on the technical review, it has been determined the Section requires clarification or additional information in order to approve the Operation Plan. Please revise the Plan to provide a response for each of the followings items:

1. Section VI. Operation Plan, Part A. General states *Yard Waste such as grass clippings, leaves, brush, and other debris (excluding pallets) is disposed of in the permitted area.* It is the Section's understanding this is not a disposal activity, but composting instead. The plan should be revised to accurately describe the composting activity including temperature measurements.
2. Section VI. Operation Plan, Part F. Hazard and Nuisance Control states *windblown material, if any, will be picked up and discarded as needed.* The plan should be revised to agree with 15A NCAC 13B.0402(7) which requires wind-blown wastes to be collected at the end of each day.

In addition to the Operation Plan revisions, the following conditions must be met in order to receive a solid waste Permit:

1. Complete an Environmental Compliance Review according to NCGS 130A-295.3
