Dear Mr. Gurley:

In response to your recent request for the permit renewal requirements for the Lake Norman Facility in Lincoln County, I am providing the list below. The permit amendment, 5 year renewal comes in two (2) parts, one (1) permit to operate and one (1) permit to construct. It is my understanding that you currently have no construction planned, the Division will reserve the permit to construct for future use. Therefore in accordance with North Carolina General Statute NCGS 130A and North Carolina Administrative Code 15A NCAC 13B submit for permit renewal an application containing the following;

1. Updated operation plan,
2. Updated closure and post-closure plan,
3. Updated financial assurance instrument, and
4. A copy of the current approved franchise agreement.

*Note: all future construction applications will be submitted in accordance with 15A NCAC 13B .0547(3).

The application should be submitted to my attention on or before August 1, 2010. Once I have received the required application the Division will invoice the Facility for the required permitting fee of \$9000.00 and perform a compliance review, prior to issuance of the permit.
