Mr. Huff:

The Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (Section) has completed review of the revised *Closure and Post-closure Plans* submitted on your behalf by McGill Associates on August 14, 2009 (DIN8418).

It has been determined the Closure and Post-Closure Plans have been prepared in accordance with Rule .0543. Therefore, Madison County has met all of the requirements of Rule .0547(2) and is approved for continued operation. Operations must be conducted according to the existing Permit to Operate except as changed by the latest approved documents as follow:

1. *Application for Continued Operation Construction & Demolition Landfill Unit 2*. Prepared by: McGill Associates. Prepared for: Madison County. June 26 2008. Document ID No. 5029.
2. *Response to Technical Review, Application for Continued Operation Construction & Demolition Landfill Unit 2*. Prepared by: McGill Associates. Prepared for: Madison County. August 14, 2009. Document ID No. 8418.

This letter is being sent in lieu of a revised Permit to Operate and must be placed in the operating record of the landfill.

The following cost estimates are approved:

Closure (Unit 2) – \$337,500

Post-closure (Unit 2) – \$375,450 (\$12,515 annually)

If you have not previously submitted the Financial Assurance documentation to Mr. Donald Herndon in the Field Operations Branch you must do so immediately. Documentation of Financial Assurance must be updated annually as required by Rule .0546.

The current Permit to Operate for this facility expires on October 18, 2011. No later than April 12, 2011 the County must submit a Permit to Operate amendment application prepared in accordance with 15A NCAC 13B.0535. If the existing facility will reach capacity prior to this date the County must submit a Permit to Construct application in accordance with 15A NCAC 13B.0547(3).

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This application should be submitted at least 120 days prior to the expiration date of the effective Permit to Operate or at least 180 days prior to the date scheduled for constructing a new phase not approved in the effective Permit to Operate.
