Dear Mr. Hulme:

North Carolina General Statute NCGS 130A-294(b2) requires that all permit applicants establish financial assurance for their solid waste management facility. It has been called to my attention that the BMWNC, Inc. Incinerator, Permit No. 60-09I, located at Campus Ridge Road in Matthews, North Carolina has not established the required financial assurance. The purpose of financial assurance is to provide for the proper disposal of waste should the owner become “insolvent or ceases to reside, be incorporated, do business, or maintain assets in the State”. The owner will provide information regarding the amount(s) and type(s) of waste processed at the facility, the cost of proper third disposal; from this information an amount of financial assurance will be determined. Once the amount is determined you will be directed to the North Carolina Administrative Code 15A NCAC 13B .1628(e) for allowable mechanisms. The Division requests that BMWNC provide the following information;

1. An estimate of the amount(s) and types(s) of waste processed at this facility in the average week. The average week should be calculated using the highest volume year, of the last five (5) years. Include the supporting data.
2. At least two (2) cost estimates, by third parties, to properly remove and dispose of the amount(s) and types(s) of waste determined in item 1.
