On March 3, 2011 the Division of Waste Management (Division) received your application for a Permit to Operate, Amendment, Ownership Change/Name Change, for the BMWNC, Inc. Medical Waste Incinerator, Permit No. 6009, located in Mecklenburg County. The application was entitled;

2. Property Ownership – Provide a copy of the deed information for the property at 3250 Campus Ridge Road.
3. Air Quality Permit – Provide a copy of the current Permit.
4. Financial Assurance – Provide Mr. Donald Herndon Division Compliance Officer with the Standby Trust, he requested in April 2011. The Standby Trust is required to complete the Financial Assurance process.
