The Mecklenburg County Compost Central facility is currently permitted by the North Carolina Department of Environment and Natural Resources (NCDENR) to operate a Large Type I Solid Waste Compost Facility under Permit #60-12. However, that permit is to expire on May 31, 2011. An application was submitted to NCDENR by Mecklenburg County on January 31, 2011 to continue composting operations at the Compost Central facility as a Large Type I facility. A letter dated March 22, 2011 was received by Mecklenburg County detailing technical review comments and requesting additional information concerning Compost Central. Mecklenburg County is in the process of obtaining the additional information; however, it is our understanding that site visits by a NCDENR Solid Waste Section representative and by a NCDENR Stormwater Permitting Unit representative still need to be scheduled prior to issuing a new permit. Mecklenburg County therefore respectfully requests an extension of the existing Permit #60-12 until such time as NCDENR has completed its review and a new permit has been issued.
