



Dear Mr. Mussler:

Per our telephone conversation on November 3, 2008 concerning the above subject, we are requesting that this letter be used to amend the existing Raleigh Transfer Station Permit # 92-15T Operations Plan. For flexibility and simplicity we would like to amend the wording in the Operations Plan Section 6, Site Requirements and Features, Pump and Haul Disposal of Washwater. Paragraph 2 of the Pump and Haul Disposal of Wastewater section on pages 5 and 6 is being amended to read from its existing wording to: "The average daily volume of washwater is approximately 400 gallons. The tank therefore accommodates washwater generated during one week of operation, if necessary. A pump haul contractor transports the washwater to a permitted facility".
