The Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section received a request for a change in the operations plan for the Raleigh Transfer Station on November 18, 2008, DIN 6370. The request involved changing from a specifically named facility to receive your washwater to any facility permitted to receive your washwater.

The specific request was to replace Paragraph 2 of the Pump and Haul Disposal of Wastewater section of the Operations Plan on pages 5 and 6 with the following:

The average daily volume of washwater is approximately 400 gallons. The tank therefore accommodates washwater generated during one week of operation, if necessary. A pump haul contractor transports the washwater to a permitted facility.
