### PART III: GENERAL PERMIT CONDITIONS

1. This permit shall expire on July 21, 2012. Pursuant to 15A NCAC 13B .1106(a), no later than May 21, 2012, the owner or operator must submit a request to the North Carolina Department of Environment and Natural Resources, Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (“Section”) for permit review and must update pertinent facility plans including, but not limited to, the facility operations plan.
2. The persons to whom this permit is issued (“permittee”) are the owners and operators of the scrap tire collection facility.
3. (Intentionally blank)
4. By receiving scrap tires at this facility the permittee shall be considered to have accepted the terms and conditions of this permit.
5. Operation of this scrap tire collection facility must be in accordance with the Solid Waste Management Rules, 15A NCAC 13B, Article 9 of the Chapter 130A of the North Carolina General Statutes (NCGS 130A-309.57, et seq.), the conditions contained in this permit; and the approved plan. Should the approved plan and the rules conflict, the Solid Waste Management Rules shall take precedence unless specifically addressed by permit condition.
6. This permit is issued based on the documents submitted in support of the application for permitting the facility including those identified in Attachment 1, Part II, “List of Documents for Approved Plan,” and which constitute the approved plan for the facility.

Where discrepancies exist, the most recent submittals and the Conditions of Permit shall govern.

7. This permit may be transferred only with the approval of the Section, through the issuance of a new or substantially amended permit in accordance with applicable statutes and rules. In accordance with NCGS 130A-295.2(g) the permittee shall notify the Section thirty (30) days prior to any significant change in the identity or business structure of either the owner or the operator, including but not limited to a proposed transfer of ownership of the facility or a change in the parent company of the owner or operator of the facility.
8. The permittee is responsible for obtaining all permits and approvals necessary for the development of this project including approval from appropriate agencies for a General or Individual NPDES Stormwater Discharge Permit. Issuance of this permit does not remove the permittee's responsibilities for compliance with any other local, state or federal rule, regulation or statute.

## **ATTACHMENT 3**

### **CONDITIONS OF PERMIT TO OPERATE**

#### **PART I: OPERATING CONDITIONS**

1. The facility is permitted to receive scrap tires as defined in NCGS 130A -309(53).
2. The facility shall be operated in accordance with the requirements of 15A NCAC 13B.1107.
3. At no time shall more than 1,000 scrap tires be stored at the facility in accordance with the financial responsibility requirements of 15A NCAC 13B. 1111, as set forth by the permittee.
4. This facility is permitted to receive scrap tires from all one hundred counties in North Carolina. Tires must be removed from the site when 250 – 300 tires are accumulated. Any unwanted tires should immediately be sent to State approved disposal facility. The approved plan identifies shipment out-of-country as the ultimate end of the tires.
5. This permit is for operation of the scrap tire collection in accordance with the approved operations plan and the original facility plan. Any revisions or modifications to these plans shall be approved by the Section.
6. The facility must not cause nuisance conditions.
7. Copies of this permit, the approved plans and all records required to be maintained by the permittee must be maintained at the facility, unless otherwise approved by the Section, and made available to the Section upon request during normal business hours.
8. The permittee must maintain a record of the amount of scrap tires received at the facility, including daily records of scrap tires received, and the amount of scrap tires shipped out from the facility, including daily records of scrap tires shipped overseas and unwanted tires sent to State approved disposal facility.
