Today, November 16, 2011, the Division of Waste Management (Division) received Domtar Paper's letter regarding Attachment 3, Condition No. 4 of the current Permit to Operate, entitled;

- *Industrial Solid Waste Landfill Facility Permit no. 9401, Domtar Paper Company, LLC – Plymouth, NC. Prepared by Domtar Paper. November 2011. DIN 15591.*

The letter questions Domtar's permitted ability to receive Weyerhaeuser Plymouth Lumber Technology Facility waste at the Landfill. The Division recognizes that the Domtar Paper Company's, Industrial Solid Waste Landfill Facility, Permit No. 9401, has received and continues to receive waste from the co-located Weyerhaeuser facility. The Landfill is approved to receive the waste as specified in the letter referenced above. The Facility shall operate in this manner until the current Permit is either amended or modified, at that time the Facility should;

1. Submit a request for the revision of the language in Attachment 3, Condition No. 4, and
2. Submit a revised Operation Plan specifying the acceptance of Weyerhaeuser waste.

The revised Plan will then be included as an approved document in the facility's Permit to Operate. Until the Permit is either amended or modified this letter and your letter, previously referenced, shall be considered approved permit documents and the Landfill shall be operated accordingly.
