The Solid Waste Section has prepared Draft Solid Waste Permit Number 94-04 approving a substantial amendment to the facility plan and the construction of Phase 2 of the Washington County Construction and Demolition Debris Landfill (C&DLF) pursuant to the North Carolina Solid Waste Management Rules (Rules) 15A NCAC 13B Sections .0531 through .0547. Washington County owns and operates the C&DLF Facility, which is located at 718 Landfill Road, Roper, in Washington County, North Carolina.

This draft permit reflects the requests of Washington County to vertically expand the C&DLF, within the same waste footprints of approximately 4 acres, by increasing the final fill elevation to approximately 46 feet above mean sea level. The request results in increasing the gross disposal capacity of the C&DLF from 117,795 cubic yards (cy) to 145,965 cy and in extending the service life by 26.3 years.

Rules require that the general public be given a 45-day period to comment on this draft permit. The comment period will begin on **May 2, 2012**, and end at 5:00 PM on **June 15, 2012**. Comments should be submitted in writing to Ming-Tai Chao, division contact, at the address listed above or via the email address at ming.chao@ncdenr.gov. All data submitted by the applicant is available as part of the administrative record and may be reviewed during business hours (9 a.m. - 4 p.m., Monday-Friday, by appointment) at the Division of Waste Management, 217 West Jones Street, Raleigh, North Carolina. A public hearing has not been scheduled for this draft permit. Any person interested in a public hearing on this draft permit should notify the division contact. If sufficient interest exists, then a public hearing will be scheduled.
