The Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (Section) has received your application requesting a transfer of permit for the medical waste treatment facility in Creswell, North Carolina (DIN 12820), Permit No. 94-06-TP. The permit was issued to Dwight Schaubach and Incendere, Inc. dba American Environmental Group AEG (Owner and Operator) and Waste Stream Solutions, LLC (Landowner) on May 22, 2009. You have requested this be transferred to WM Healthcare Solutions, Inc. due to your purchase of the facility.

The Section understands that there will be a transition period between the purchase of the facility and the issuance of our permit decision.
