The Solid Waste Section has prepared Draft Solid Waste Permit Number 9601-CDLF-1997, allowing the Wayne County Construction and Demolition Debris Landfill (C&DLF) to continue operations of Phases 1 & 2 pursuant to the North Carolina Solid Waste Management Rules, 15A NCAC 13B .0547(4). The C&DLF owned and operated by Wayne County is located on 460 B South Landfill Road in Dudley, North Carolina 28333 and encompasses approximately 40-acre waste footprints. The C&DLF is seated on top of the closed 112-acre Municipal Solid Waste Landfill (MSWLF) and has a gross capacity for waste disposal of 2,736,883 cubic yards. The draft permit also includes conditions for operating miscellaneous waste management units at the facility.

Impact to groundwater from the closed, unlined MSWLF requires the implementation of a corrective action plan. An assessment of corrective measures for groundwater treatment was presented at the public meeting held on February 8, 2008. Monitored natural attenuation was the selected remedy. The remedy will combine the existing institutional controls, capping for the source control, and a gas collection and control system to control decomposition gases. The draft permit contains conditions for the implementation, operation, and assessment of the corrective action plan.

Rules require that the general public be given a 45-day period to comment on this draft permit. The comment period will begin on June 2, 2012, and end at 5:00 p.m. on July 16, 2012. Comments should be submitted in writing to Ming-Tai Chao, division contact, at the address listed above or via the email address ming.chao@ncdenr.gov. All data submitted by the applicant is available as part of the administrative record and may be reviewed during business hours (9 a.m. - 4 p.m., Monday-Friday, by appointment) at the Division of Waste Management, 217 West Jones Street, Raleigh, North Carolina. A public hearing has not been scheduled for this draft permit. Any person interested in a public hearing on this draft permit should notify the division contact. If sufficient interest exists, then a public hearing will be scheduled.
