Mr. Thompson:

The Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (Section) has received the email (DIN10289) requesting an extension of the Ore Knob ash removal project. The email was received in the Asheville Regional Office on April 6, 2010.

The Section is approving the extension for removal of ash waste from the Louisiana-Pacific Industrial Landfill at the Roaring River Facility (Permit #97-03) as specified with the following conditions:

1. The material may only be transported by the USEPA contractor and transported to the USEPA Ore Knob site in Ashe County for remediation purposes.
2. The material must be covered at all times during transport to prevent fugitive particulate emissions and nuisance conditions.
3. All material removed from the landfill must be weighed and the total removed from the facility must be reported to the Section at the end of the project.
4. The removal of material may not contravene any existing permit conditions or the approved Operations Plan.
5. Approval for the removal activity is valid for 12 months from the date of this letter. A request for extension must be made to the Section if additional time is required.
