HOW WAS THE FIRE REPORTED AND BY WHOM:
I called Ray Williams with DENR, right after calling 911, and left a message because it was after hours and he later called me back. I was alerted of the fire by neighbors that live by the LCID's (Willis Farm)

LIST ACTIONS TAKEN:
Called 911, firetrucks showed up but a smaller truck with a water tank came close and sprayed water into the woods behind the LCID. We then later took the dozer & excavator to put dirt in the holes to snuff the smoke out and spread more dirt.

WHAT WAS THE CAUSE OF THE FIRE:
Suspect Grass fire because there was evidence of trespassers and that they had started a fire.

DESCRIBE AREA, TYPE, AND AMOUNT OF WASTE INVOLVED:
A few yards of debris (6-10 yards)

WHAT COULD HAVE BEEN DONE TO PREVENT THIS FIRE:
Nothing. The gate was locked and the LCID was and is in Total Compliance, had been closed out for about 6 years and covered with dirt and grass for that same amount of time.

DESCRIBE PLAN OF ACTIONS TO PREVENT FUTURE INCIDENTS:
We spread more dirt and the Sheriff's department is monitoring to prevent future unauthorized entries.
