Attached is the completed Industrial Landfill Annual Report form for Duke Energy's Marshall Steam Station Industrial Landfill No. 1 (Permit No. 18-12) for the past year (7/1/2011 – 6/30/2012).

The landfill only accepts waste from Duke Energy's Marshall Steam Station. A total of approximately 345,086 tons of waste was received by the landfill during the most recent twelve month period. Since operation, approximately 278,800 cubic yards of waste has been disposed of in the landfill.
