Dear Mr. Hardin:

This letter is in response to your call today requesting information on permitting a construction and demolition solid waste landfill (C&DLF). The Solid Waste Management Rules (Rules) addressing this process are attached.

The initial step in this process is the preparation of a Site Study which is addressed in 15A North Carolina Administrative Code (NCAC) 13B .0536. The Division of Waste Management must review the Site Study **prior** to consideration of an application for a permit to construct a C&DLF. Please note that the Site Study must include local government approvals in addition to site characterization, plans, and reports. Local government approvals required are listed in 15A NCAC 13B .0536(c) (11). Obtaining a franchise from the local government is one of the approvals. Everything must be documented as described in the Site Study rules.

The description of an application for a permit to construct a new facility begins in NCAC 13B .0533 "General Application Requirement and Processing for C&DLF" and then follows with the other rules that describe the contents and preparation of plans, drawings, and reports. Plans and drawings must be prepared and sealed by a NC licensed professional engineer. The Hydrologic Report must be prepared and sealed by a NC licensed geologist.

There are also financial requirements. The fee for a new permit is \$15,000 for a landfill accepting less than 100,000 tons per year fee and \$30,000 for ones accepting 100,000 tons per year or more. The annual fee is \$2,750. (North Carolina General Statute 130A-295.8) Financial assurance for closure and post-closure costs must also be in place prior to receiving waste.
