Subject: Traffic Impact on SR 2048 (Roy Lopp Rd.) in Lexington, Davidson County.

Mr. Warfford:

We have received your request for a waiver of a traffic impact study concerning the addition of a C&D Recycling Station to your existing processing facility located on Roy Lopp Road. This roadway has a current average annual daily traffic (AADT) of 920 vehicles.

You indicated that the recycling station would produce approximately 30 additional trips during the peak summer months. Due to the current AADT and the anticipated additional truck traffic, we do not expect any adverse traffic impacts to the existing roadway network in the vicinity of your facility. Therefore, we would not request a traffic study giving this information.
