The Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section received the following letters requesting changes to for your facility's operations manual.

1. Letter from Madeline German, P.G., and Stacey Smith, P.E., of Smith Gardner, Inc. November 30, 2012. (DIN 17937). The letter requests approval to place 40 cubic yard roll-off container onsite for the management of metals found in land clearing and inert debris. The container will be placed in a location that does not interfere with the landfill operation and will be removed when full.
2. Letter from Madeline German, PG, and Stacey Smith, PE, December 7, 2012 (DIN 17938). The letter proposes a soil screening plan to minimize the possibility of the acceptance of potentially contaminated materials at the facility. A subsequent letter dated January 8, 2013, (DIN 18115), revised the plan based on staff comments.
