The North Carolina Solid Waste Section records indicate the Permit for this landfill facility located at the intersection of Midland Terrace Road and Camden Avenue has expired. Photos taken in February 2012 depict a sign on the gate that states the landfill is closed.

Therefore, this facility is considered closed and Permit No. 32-H is rescinded.

If this property is to be used again for landfilling operations, then the responsible party must submit a complete permit application in accordance with North Carolina General Statute NCGS 130A-294 and must meet the requirements of North Carolina Administrative Code 15A NCAC 13B, prior to any construction and /or waste activities commencing at this subject site.
