Dear Mr. Barker:

On February 19, 2010, a Permit to Construct and Operate a Construction and Demolition Debris (C&D) Transfer Station and Recycling Operation Facility was issued to Organic Partners, LLC (landowner) and Organic Recycling Center, LLC (operator). Attachment 2 of the Conditions of the Permit to Construct (Part I, Item No. 2) states "The initial, substantial construction authorized by the Permit to Construct must commence within 18 months from the issuance date of this permit. If substantial construction does not begin within 18 months from the issuance date of this permit, then the permit shall expire. Substantial construction includes, but is not limited to, issuance of construction contracts, mobilization of equipment on site, and construction activities including installation of sedimentation and erosion control structures."

A site inspection of the facility conducted by the NC Solid Waste Section personnel on August 17, 2012 indicated that no visible construction or other conditions meeting the criteria of substantial construction had been met. A period of thirty (30) months has passed since issuance of the permit and therefore, the Facility Permit No. 35-05T-Transfer-2010 has expired.

The permittee may re-apply for the Permit to Construct and the re-application will be subject to the statutes and rules in effect on that date and may be subject to additional fees. If you feel that an error has been made in the decision of permit expiration, please provide documentation confirming commencement of substantial construction which meets the conditions listed in the Permit No. 35-05T-Transfer-2010.
