The North Carolina Division of Waste Management (DWM) has reviewed subject report and has the following comments:

- 1) Six water level monitoring wells were not found in the field. It is necessary to locate PW-19 since there are no wells in the vicinity and the water level information from this well is important to evaluation the groundwater flow direction and the impact on the flow regime from the water level change in the lake.
- 2) Please submit a repair or replacement plan for damaged wells.
- 3) Figure 2 needs a scale bar.
- 4) Please send a letter to this office, by May 15, 2013, regarding the status of the remediation system. The system startup date was approved to be postponed to December 31, 2012. We have not received any status updates on the system.
