The Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (Section) has received your request to transfer the permit for the Burnt Poplar C&D Transfer Station (Permit No. 41-22T). The request was pursuant to your purchase of the facility from Burnt Poplar Transfer, LLC and WCA Waste Systems, Inc.

Your application is considered complete within the context of NCGS §130A-295.8(e). A determination of completeness means that the application includes all required components but does not mean that the required components provide all of the information that is required for the Section to make a decision on the application.

Under NCGS §150B-3, when an applicant makes a timely and sufficient application for issuance or renewal of a permit, the existing permit does not expire until a final decision on the application is made. Therefore, until the final decision is made, you are authorized to continue operation of the Burnt Poplar C&D Transfer Station in accordance with the most recent Solid Waste Permit and the Solid Waste Management Rules (15A NCAC 13B).

The new permit will be issued to WI Burnt Poplar Transfer, LLC (a wholly owned subsidiary of Waste Industries USA, Inc.) and the facility name will remain Burnt Poplar C&D Transfer Station.
