The Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section, received your request of September 24, 2012, to modify the way in which you manage the construction and demolition debris (C&D) waste stream at the Burnt Poplar Transfer Station.

You requested that the transfer station be allowed to add and use pre-compaction equipment due to the reduced volume of waste currently received at the facility. The pre-crusher unit and compaction station will be located on the existing concrete tipping pad. A drawing showing the equipment location and a brochure describing the compaction equipment were provided. Adding this equipment will provide the flexibility to match transport containers and vehicles with the C&D waste market, resulting in better utilization of your waste transportation fleets.
