Dear Mr. Blanchard:

My name is Ming-Tai Chao, and I will be the permitting engineer to assist you in obtaining a valid operating permit at your facility – Harnett County – Dunn/Erwin Waste Transfer Facility, Permit No. 43-07T which permit to operate (PTO) has expired. To assist you in preparing the permit amendment application for a five-year review of the above-referenced transfer station, I am attaching the “*Application Guidance for a MSW Transfer Station*” to this e-mail message.

Please also provide a copy of the land deed and any available current plates, surveying drawings of the property in the permit application; the land deed info will be incorporated into the new PTO. If the leachate is subjected to pump and haul and disposed of the local public-owned waste water treatment plant, please provide a copy of the liquid wastes disposal agreement/ approval document. If the leachate will be treated by on-site water treatment units and discharged to on-site drainage features, the approved NPDES permit document (s) must be appended to the permit application.

Pursuant to NCGS 13A-295.3, Harnett County- Dunn/Erwin Waste Transfer Facility is subjected to the environmental compliance review. To expedite the permitting processes, I will make a request to conduct the review upon receiving the **completed permit amendment application** for this transfer station. The Solid Waste Section Compliance Officer will send you or the County a questionnaire and other related document. Please complete the request as soon as possible.

Pursuant to NCGS 13A-295.2, Permit holders - Harnett County must provide acceptable financial assurance mechanisms to cover the costs for the closure of the transfer station when it occurs. Please prepare the cost estimate for facility closure in accordance with the Section 5 (item 34) of the “*Application Guidance for a MSW Transfer Station.*”

Please send a hard copy and an electronic copy (in pdf format) of the completed permit application for the waste transfer facility to the following address:

The County needs to pay the statutorily required fee in a mount of \$3,000.00 for reviewing the permit amendment application for a 5-year review.
