OBSERVED VIOLATIONS

The item(s) listed above were observed by Section staff and require action on behalf of the facility in order to come into or maintain compliance with the Statutes, Rules, and/or other regulatory requirements applicable to this facility. Be advised that pursuant to N.C.G.S. 130A-22, an administrative penalty of up to \$15,000 per day may be assessed for each violation of the Solid Waste Laws, Regulations, Conditions of a Permit, or Order under Article 9 of Chapter 130A of the N.C. General Statutes. Further, the facility and/or all responsible parties may be subject to enforcement actions including penalties, injunction from operation of a solid waste management facility or a solid waste collection service and any such further relief as may be necessary to achieve compliance with the North Carolina Solid Waste Management Act and Rules.

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ADDITIONAL COMMENTS

An inspection of the county municipal waste transfer station was conducted with Don Russell, County Solid Waste Director.

1. Documentation was on site and available during this inspection.
2. The permit to operate was issued December 19, 2012.
3. The facility tip pad and trailer loading area was clean and being well managed at the time of the audit. The facility is cleaned daily according to county staff. Looked good.
4. The wooden side walls of the facility are being maintained and a safety chain installed at the trailer loading area.
5. The facility is receiving approximately 440 tons per week.
6. It is recommended that waste screenings are conducted on at least 1% of the waste. Ensure that the waste screenings are documented accordingly.
7. The site staff training was current.
8. The leachate collection drain was clean.
9. The leachate tank is pumped weekly by Safety Kleen according site personnel.
10. White goods were being managed properly at the time of this audit. Site personnel remove the Freon from the appliances before being removed as scrap metal. Freon is stored until removed by contractor for proper disposal. I recommend that you contact the Division of Environmental Assistance and Outreach to assist with finding a market for recycling your Freon.
11. The electronics were being managed properly at the time of this audit. Electronics are placed in boxes on pallets or stacked and shrink wrapped on pallets until they can be removed by the contractor.
12. The county is in the process of contracting with a different electronics recycling vendor.
13. Scrap tires were being managed properly at the time of this audit. Ensure that the most current scrap tire certification forms are being used when receiving tires.
14. Continue to monitor the full trailers of waste that are staged outside the WTS to ensure they are not leaking. Some of the trailers observed onsite during this inspection had holes in them that have the potential to leak.
15. Digital photos were taken during the inspection.
