DESCRIPTION

In accordance with the Solid Waste Management Rules, specifically Rule 15A NCAC 13B .1603(a)(1)(B), the proposed expansion of an existing municipal solid waste landfill (MSWLF) facility's unit boundary requires a new facility permit. This draft permit reflects the request of Iredell County to expand the landfill facility in order to increase the MSWLF waste footprint from approximately 83 acres to 115.64 acres and expand the total gross capacity of the MSWLF to approximately 12,534,121 cubic yards from 6,661,380 cubic yards. The approved facility boundary, including buffer areas, will increase from 248 acres to approximately 315.872 acres. This draft permit does not authorize any change to the service area, daily tonnage volume, or characteristics of waste stream established in the previous permit.

Iredell County owns and operates the MSWLF which is located on 3260 Twin Oakes Road, SR 2319, Iredell County, North Carolina.

The Division has determined that the proposed facility plan, engineering plan, construction quality assurance plan, operation plan, closure and post-closure plan, and the water quality monitoring plan, as identified in the application, satisfy the requirements and intent of the North Carolina Solid Waste Management Rules, codified as 15A NCAC 13B .1600.

PERMIT STRUCTURE

The permit is divided into two parts, the Permit to Construct, and the Permit to Operate, each consist of a list of Approved Documents, and specific conditions for the construction, operation, and monitoring of the landfill units. A copy of the draft Permit to Construct is attached.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

North Carolina Solid Waste Management Rules require that the public be given an opportunity to comment on a draft permit for a municipal solid waste management facility. This 45-day comment period begins on March 13, 2013 and ends on April 29, 2013 at 4:00 PM.

The application and draft permit is available for review during business hours (9 AM- 4 PM, Monday-Friday, by appointment) at the Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section, Mooresville Regional Office, 610 East Center Ave. Mooresville, NC 28115. The administrative record including the application, fact sheet, and draft permit may be view online at <http://portal.ncdenr.org/web/wm/sw> Select the “Documents” link from the list on the left side of the page. Once redirected, enter **4903-MSWLF-1993** in the “ID” field and then click the “Search” button or select the “Public Notices” tab in the center of the page to find related documents for issuance of this permit.

Persons who wish to comment on either this permit or the proposed permit conditions or to object to the permit issuance should submit their comments in writing by April 29, 2013 at 4:00 PM. Comments should be sent to the address shown below and include the permit number. All comments received within the 45-day period will be considered in making the final determinations regarding the permit.
